

Handling of waste generated during the spread of the “Covid-19” virus

During the outbreak of the “Covid-19” virus, it is necessary to ensure essential services to the public, which includes securing the protection of human health and the environment in the sphere of waste management.

Responsible waste management by all is crucial at this time.

Waste management in households with “Covid-19” positive people or people in mandatory quarantine:

- Waste from these households, including used personal protective equipment (gloves and masks) is **double-bagged and firmly closed**.
- The bag is discarded **in** the container **with unsorted waste**. Do not place the bag near the container or in the sorted waste container.
- Unsorted household waste is collected according to schedule.
- **Thoroughly treat your hands with disinfectant immediately after disposal!**

Sorted waste collection points and containers:

Note: As in the past, only those materials fit for recycling are to be deposited in the sorted waste containers as marked on the said container. **Disposable wipes, paper towels, sanitary napkins and diapers are not to be disposed of in the sorted waste containers.**

Sorted waste collection areas:

- As in the past, glass bottles and jars, paper, cardboard, polymers, PET bottles and metal are to be deposited in the containers located in the sorted waste collection areas and in doing so **keep a distance of 3 meters between you and the sorted waste collection area manager and other people.**
- Collection of **large waste, green waste and construction waste** is ensured in accordance with the procedure established in your area by the local municipality or operator.
